We offer two distinct types of pizza:

Chicago Style – A pan-cooked pizza made upside down – cheese on the bottom and sauce on the top.

&

Thin Crust – a crackery thin crust cut into squares.

We believe our pizza is unlike any other in Kansas City. We use a completely separate dough recipe for our two varieties of pizza and we'll make both of them right here, everyday. We think it's worth it. We hope you agree.

Our 100% Wisconsin Mozzarella is the some of the best and most expensive in the US. No preservatives or fillers. It's shipped to us specially sealed to preserve the original flavor. We are the first and only ones in Kansas City to use this Mozzarella blend.

Our sauce is made with California grown, fresh-packed tomatoes, our own blend of spices, and a little something extra we can't tell you about.

Just like everything else, we'll use the freshest toppings we can find. That includes fresh local meat

products (no pre-cooked balls-o-meat) and fresh vegetables cut daily. We may not even have a freezer in this place.
